It has been suggested by others in the invention promotion watchdog arena that I submit my complaint with you. Being that I am filing a complaint with the UPSTO with respect to the American Inventors Protection Act of 1999, I am submitting that same information to you.

I want to inform you of my dissatisfaction with Inventors Publishing & Research. The attached should give you the details. I purchased their services in late 2005, having signed the contract on October 28, and paying the up front fee on November 14<sup>th</sup>.

My complaint concerns can be found on the following pages. To solve the problem, we are pursuing arbitration with them. Being a novice in the legal arena, my business partner and I did not consider or even know about the help that the state may offer. Being that our hearing is on March 27, 2007, it leaves us little time to speak with you. However, you may still be able to show up at the case, speak with us, or help us get our money back. We are in fact asking for all of our money back, plus travel costs, arbitration costs, lost time with our patent, and stress and anxiety. In all we are asking for \$50,000. The nightmare they have put us through has been unenjoyable.
